Master's Course

1. Department and number of students for admission

Mathematics Course: Offers guidance on researches in Mathematics and Mathematical Sciences and on writing a Master's Thesis. A successful student will be awarded a Master's Degree in Mathematics (Master of Mathematics).

MMA (Master of Mathematics Administration) Course: Admits students from a wide range of departments with mathematical requirements, and aims to train professionals with high mathematical abilities and with a broad outlook. A successful student will be awarded a Master's Degree in Mathematics Administration (Master of Mathematics Administration).

2. Qualification for application

Applicants must be citizens of countries other than Japan with a residence status of "college student" (including those who are expected to acquire this status after being admitted), and satisfy one of the following requirements:

- (1) Those who have completed 16 years of formal education in countries other than Japan (including those who are expected to complete such education by March 2011).
- (2) Those who have completed 15 years of formal education in countries other than Japan, and are judged by the Graduate School to have obtained all necessary credits with excellent academic records.
- (3) Those who are evaluated in an individual screening of requirements for admission of the Graduate School to have an academic ability equal to or surpassing those who have graduated from a university, and who will be 22 years old before April 1, 2011.

(Note) "(3) Those who are evaluated in an individual screening of requirements for admission of the Graduate School ..." applies to those applicants who do not satisfy requirements (1) or (2), and who have completed a course at an institution with educational functions equivalent to those of a university.

(Note) Preliminary qualification examination for application

Applicants who qualify under (2) or (3) above must submit themselves to a preliminary qualification examination for application. Such an applicant must submit the application form and other relevant documents to the Student Affairs Office, Graduate School of Social and Cultural Studies, by the deadline specified below, after receiving an approval from his/her planned supervisor (in case of MMA course, the applicant must make contact with the Director of the Department of Mathematics, prior to the submission of the documents).

Applicants who have passed the qualification examination are qualified to take the entrance screening examination, and the application form and other relevant documents submitted by such applicants shall be accepted.

Examination cards, etc. shall be sent to applicants after payment of the screening fee is confirmed. Documents submitted by those who have been judged to be “not qualified” for application as a result of the preliminary examination shall be returned.

- Application period: December 6 (Mon.) to December 10 (Fri.), 2010
- Notification of qualification examination result: December 22(Wed.), 2010

3. Documents to be submitted

- (1) Application form and curriculum vitae (use the form specified by the Graduate School)
- (2) Academic record certificate, graduation (expected graduation) certificate and recommendation letter issued by the institution from which the applicant last graduated (copies not accepted)
- (3) Certificate of Japanese language ability
- (4) Certificate of alien registration (submitted only by those currently residing in Japan)
- (5) Entrance screening fee: 30,000 yen (payment not required for foreign students under government scholarship)

Follow the procedure below to make payment of 30,000 yen as the entrance screening fee, and submit the screening fee payment note.

Using a ballpoint pen, correctly and clearly enter all the necessary items in bold line columns of the payment request form (for Kyushu University entrance screening fee) attached to this guideline. Then take the form without separating its A, B and C slips to a bank. After completing the payment, firmly affix the Kyushu University Entrance Screening Fee Receipt (C slip), which is one of the documents returned from the bank, to the position specified for the Entrance Screening Fee Receipt on the back of the screening fee payment note, and write your course, address and name on the front side of the note. Then enclose the note with the other application documents. When filling out the forms, please refer to the examples of the payment request form (for Kyushu University entrance screening fee) and the Kyushu University Entrance Screening Fee Receipt (C slip)

of the screening fee payment note, provided in the “application documents file.”

- Payment through Japan Post Bank, ATM or the Internet is not available.
 - ★ As the C slip with a stamp cannot be obtained for transfer with ATM/Internet or between accounts of Japan Post Bank, please use banks where the transfer can be done at a counter.
- No transfer fee is charged when payment is made at the head office or a branch office of Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation. If payment is made at any other bank, the transfer fee charged shall be borne by the applicant.
- Payment must be made by wire transfer on or after January 12(Wed.), 2011.

(6) 3 photos of yourself (taken within 3 months, 5.5 cm × 4.5 cm, to be affixed to the application form and the examination card)

(7) An envelope (for sending the examination card, screening schedule, etc. A standard-size envelope with an 80-yen stamp affixed, and with the applicant’s name, address and postal code written. Not required for students who are currently postgraduates of Kyushu University. Those who are subject to a preliminary qualification examination must submit 2 envelopes.)

(Note) Applicants who are subject to a preliminary examination must submit the documents below, in addition to the documents specified above.

- a Research plan: 2 sets (Write horizontally on A4-size paper with approx. 2,000 characters in Japanese or 1,300 words in English about what you want to study after enrolling. One photocopied version may be accepted.)
- b Certificate of research history (prepared by the President or the Dean of the university from which the applicant last graduated or by the head of the institution the applicant belongs to)

(Notes for preparing documents)

- I All documents should be prepared either in Japanese or in English. (Use of a word processor of PC is acceptable.)
- II If any of the necessary documents is prepared in a language other than Japanese or English, a Japanese or English translation should be attached.

(Notes for submitting documents)

- I Write "Application form for Master's Course of the Graduate School of Mathematics enclosed" in red on the front of the envelope.
- II The application form and other related documents shall be accepted from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, except national holidays. When mailing the documents, use registered mail and make sure the documents arrive before the deadline.

6. Procedures for screening

Screening of applicants is conducted mainly based on the documents submitted. Academic examination may be given when necessary.

- (1) Screening shall be conducted separately for the Mathematics Course and the MMA Course.
- (2) Academic examination shall be given on the applicants' specialized subjects, and foreign and Japanese languages, in written or oral form.
- (3) Applicants will be informed of the method and schedule of screening after their application documents have been accepted.

10. About MMA Course

- MMA (Master of Mathematics Administration) is a Mathematics version of MOT, known worldwide as the technology version of MBA.
- The aim of the MMA Course is to train professionals who understand the importance of foundational researches with mathematical background and who can carry out the coordination or the management of research developments with global viewpoints and a long-term outlook.
- A supervisor will be arranged for each student. During the 4 semesters, there will be seminars of 4 different themes conducted by different professors. Students will be required to regularly submit reports about the seminars, and they will be corrected by Teaching Assistants: in this way, the students will aim to develop high mathematical abilities and a wide range of outlook.

2. Qualification for application

Applicants must be citizens of countries other than Japan with a residence status of “college student” (including those who are expected to acquire this status after being admitted), and satisfy one of the following requirements:

- (1) Those who hold or are to receive a degree equivalent to a Master’s degree in countries other than Japan by March 2011.
- (2) Those who are evaluated in an individual screening of requirements for admission of the Graduate School to have an academic ability equal to or surpassing that of a holder of a Master’s degree, and who will be 24 years old before April 1, 2011.

(Note) “(2) Those who are evaluated in an individual screening of requirements for admission of the Graduate School ...” applies to those applicants who do not satisfy requirement (1), and who have completed a course at an institution with educational functions equivalent to those of a graduate school.

(Note) Preliminary qualification examination for application

Applicants who qualify under (2) above must submit themselves to a preliminary qualification examination for application. Such an applicant must submit the application form and other relevant documents to the Student Affairs Office, Graduate School of Social and Cultural Studies, by the deadline specified below, after receiving an approval from his/her planned supervisor.

Applicants who have passed the qualification examination are qualified to take the entrance screening examination, and the application form and other relevant documents submitted by such applicants shall be accepted.

- (5) Certificate of alien registration (submitted only by those currently residing in Japan)
- (6) Entrance screening fee: 30,000 yen (payment not required for foreign students under government scholarship)

1. Those who will finish a Master's course of a graduate school of Kyushu University in March 2011 and intend to continuously enter the Doctoral Course of the Graduate School of Mathematics
2. Those who will finish the second year of a 5-year doctoral course of a graduate school of Kyushu University acquiring a Master's degree in March 2011, and intend to continuously enter the Doctoral Course of the Graduate School of Mathematics
3. Those who will finish a professional degree course of a graduate school of Kyushu University in March 2011, and intend to continuously enter the Doctoral Course of the Graduate School of Mathematics
4. Those who have completed one of the courses mentioned above less than one year ago and satisfy one of the following:
 - (1) Those who finished a Master's course, etc. in the middle of 2010 due to a reason such as leave of absence or studying abroad
 - (2) Those who finished a Master's course, etc. in the middle of 2010 due to their autumn enrollment.(Note) If you are not certain, please consult the Student Affairs Office, Graduate School of Social and Cultural Studies, in advance.
