Dear Students of Graduate school of Mathematics,

We inform you about classes and term-end-exams in the second semester (October 1, 2020 ~ February 12, 2021).

Kyushu University has already informed on the website that classes will be conducted online at the second semester in general. However, in the cases of ①the courses or the researches that are required or be desirable to be conducted in-person, or ②the term-end-exams that are difficult to evaluate when they are conducted online, in-person classes are held.

Please check which courses are conducted in-person or not by the timetable.

※Depending on the infection circumstance of COVID-19, if in-person classes or exams are changed to online, we inform it on the website of Graduate school of Mathematics.

(Notes when you come to Campus)

- Take your temperature every day, grasp your health condition.
